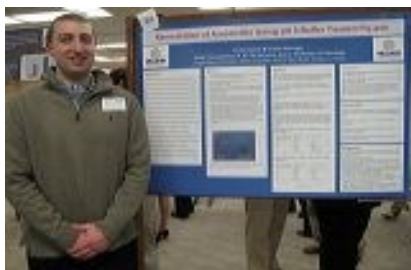


Do you meet the following qualifications?

4. Have at least a 3.0 grade point average in all subjects including Science and Mathematics.

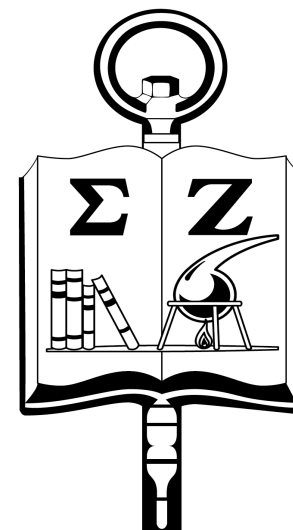
